Applications may be submitted by jurisdictions that have eligible candidates. All candidates must meet the NSBOA Regular Membership prerequisites:

- Equivalent experience in the construction industry or similar field.

Candidates selected to participate in the program will receive a copy of the current National Building Code and will be trained to the Residential Building Official Qualification level.
